**NO DRY ICE, LIQUID
NITROGEN, OR
COMPRESSED GAS**
(except breathing air)



**NO FLAMMABLE
LIQUIDS OR GAS**



**NO VOLATILE
CHEMICALS**
(including acids)



NO FOOD OR DRINKS



NO OPEN FLAMES



**STORE HAZARDOUS
CHEMICALS IN LAB
FRIDGES***

To prevent mold:

- Reduce or don't use cardboard, wood, cloth, and paper
- Report water leaks and surface condensation to facilities
- Latch doors
- Quickly clean spills and dry surfaces



*If you can't store chemicals in lab fridges, store them in secondary containers in cold rooms but don't use them in cold rooms. Don't store hazardous chemicals in warm rooms.
